### **Jet set with SWISS from Miami this winter.**

**Global jet-setting is made easy when traveling with Swiss International Air Lines Ltd., from Miami to Switzerland, and beyond. Ski the Alps, then head to any of the award-winning airline's other 72 worldwide destinations being offered this winter including new service from Zurich to Beijing starting February 2012.**

SWISS offers three classes of service from Miami: SWISS First, SWISS Business, and SWISS Economy. In SWISS Business, passengers enjoy superb comfort that they control. The fully horizontal lie-flat SWISS Business bed is 79 inches long and includes an innovative air cushion technology. This technology enables passengers to individually adjust comfort levels to meet personal requirements. SWISS is one of the only airlines to offer this seat technology. Passengers can also opt for a relaxing massage function. Cabin configuration is 1-2-1 or 2-2-1 with most seats having direct aisle access, allowing for more privacy and additional storage space. Board SWISS's premium cabins and be welcomed with a refreshing glass of juice or champagne toast.

From Miami, the schedule is as follows:

Other USA gateways include: Boston, Chicago, New York, Newark, Los Angeles, and San Francisco. Connecting through Zurich Airport is simple and enticing as passengers often wish to shop their way through upscale stores and Swiss speciality shops.

In addition to Beijing, which will be SWISS's third destination in China (others are Hong Kong, Shanghai), a new Geneva-Nice service will also be introduced. Services from Zurich and Geneva to London, Moscow, and Madrid will be increased. In Geneva, SWISS will gradually expand its operations portfolio in Europe in the months ahead. SWISS has increased the number of flights to London City from four to five daily. As of 16 December,

two daily flights to Moscow will be offered. As of 10 February 2012, SWISS will link Geneva with the Côte d'Azur by serving Nice twice daily with an Airbus A319. Simultaneous with the start of the Nice service, SWISS will strengthen its presence in Spain by increasing the number of daily flights from Geneva to Madrid from two to three. With the introduction of service to Nice and the frequency in increase for Madrid, SWISS will have 10 aircraft at Geneva's International Airport.

#### **Edelweiss Air / SWISS holiday flights**

Together with its partner Edelweiss Air, SWISS offers flights to popular holiday destinations around the world. Twice weekly service from Zurich to Cape Town and Colombo are part of this product, while Hurghada and Sharm el Sheikh become two new holiday destinations, served once weekly from Geneva.
