



SWISS INTERNATIONAL AIR LINES LTD. & US AIRWAYS TEAM UP Announcing Codeshare Agreement: New Options For Philadelphia Passengers

New York, April 18, 2008 -- Announcing a new SWISS and US Airways codeshare agreement that offers SWISS passengers the opportunity to fly from Philadelphia to Zurich on US Airways-operated flights starting April 26. US Airways passengers will have onward connections from Zurich operated by SWISS to 10 European destinations.

As members of the Star Alliance, SWISS and US Airways are intensifying their collaboration with this new codeshare agreement offering sizeable further benefits to both partner customers. SWISS customers will have a new daily service between Philadelphia and Zurich (operated by US Airways). These codeshared routes go on sale April 19 for travel April 26 and beyond. US Airways operates a Boeing 767 with two class seating on this route. As on all Star Alliance airlines, Miles & More members will be able to earn and redeem program miles on these flights.

US Airways also becomes SWISS’ codeshare partner on services to 10 destinations in Europe and passengers will be offered SWISS-operated onward connections from Zurich to Athens, Bucharest, Düsseldorf, Geneva, Hanover, Luxembourg, Nice, Nuremberg, Stuttgart and Vienna.

“We’re delighted to offer our customer’s flying from Philadelphia to Zurich greater access to Europe through our new codeshare relationship with SWISS. Our Zurich-bound customer’s now have seamless connections to 10 European cities in seven countries across Europe. We also welcome SWISS customers on our Philadelphia-Zurich route giving them another U.S. gateway destination,” said Andrew Nocella, US Airways’ senior vice president, schedule, planning and alliances.
